Micro Economics, Economy of Maharashtra, Macro Economics, Banking, Indian Economy and Demography are the major papers being taught at UG level. As per the rules and regulations of Government of Maharashtra and the parent university, i.e. Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati one full time post is sanctioned for this department. Professor Hansraj G. Phatak was the first Head of the Department – an expert in Monetary Economics and Finance. Presently, Professor Dr. Dnyaneshwar V. Gore has been leading the department since November, 2007; specializes in the Agricultural Economics & Econometrics.

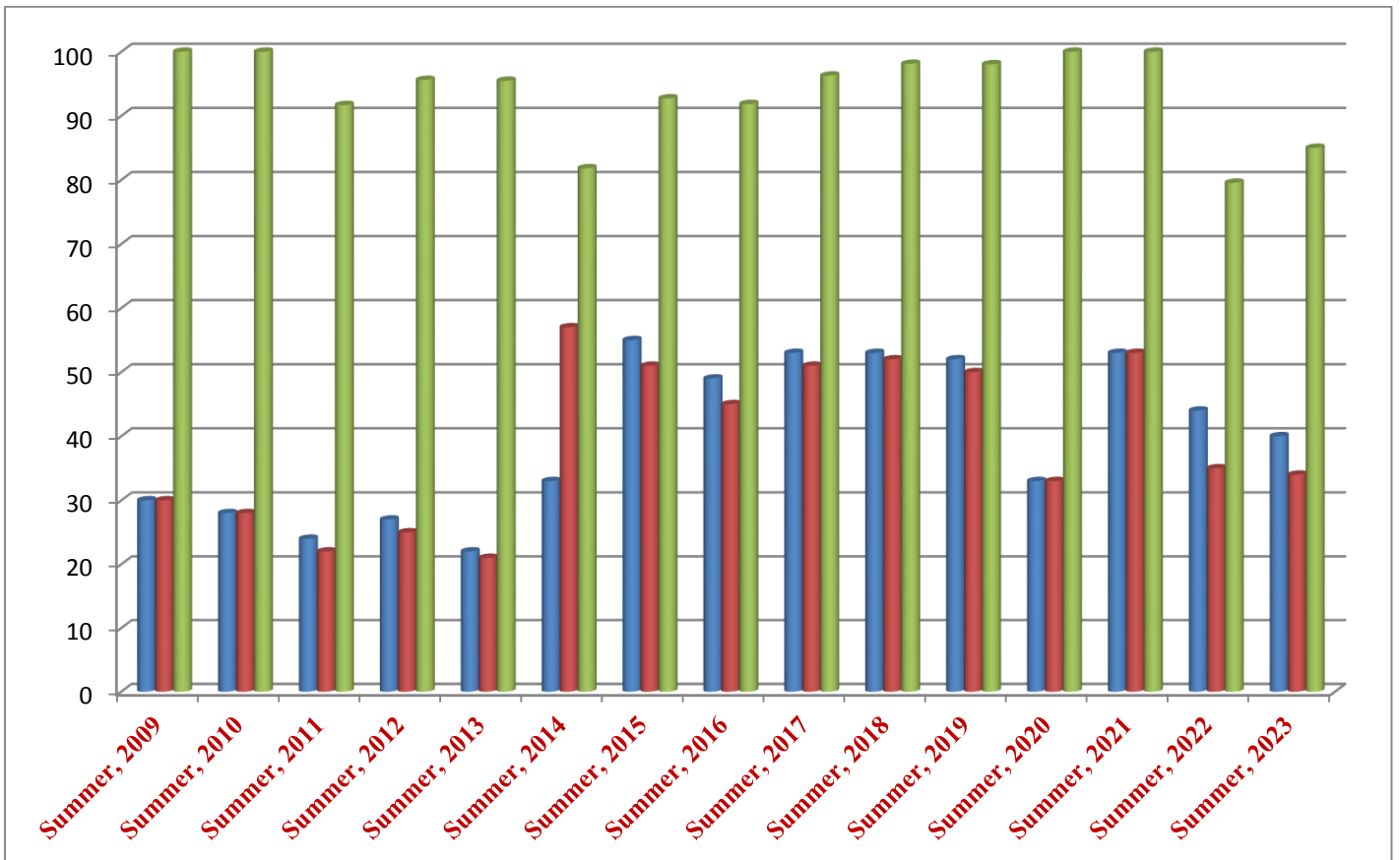
