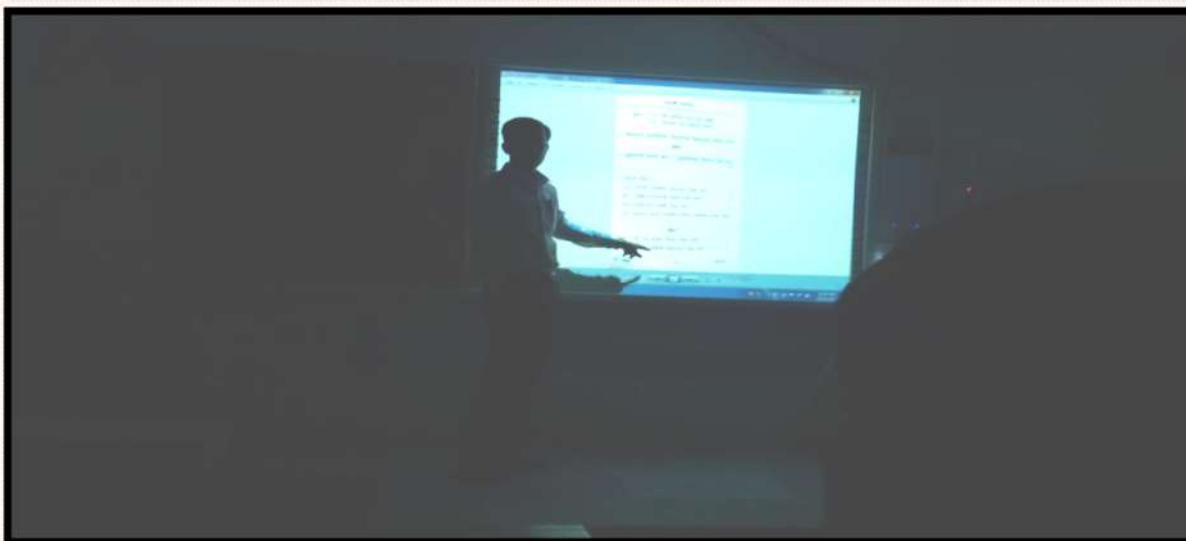

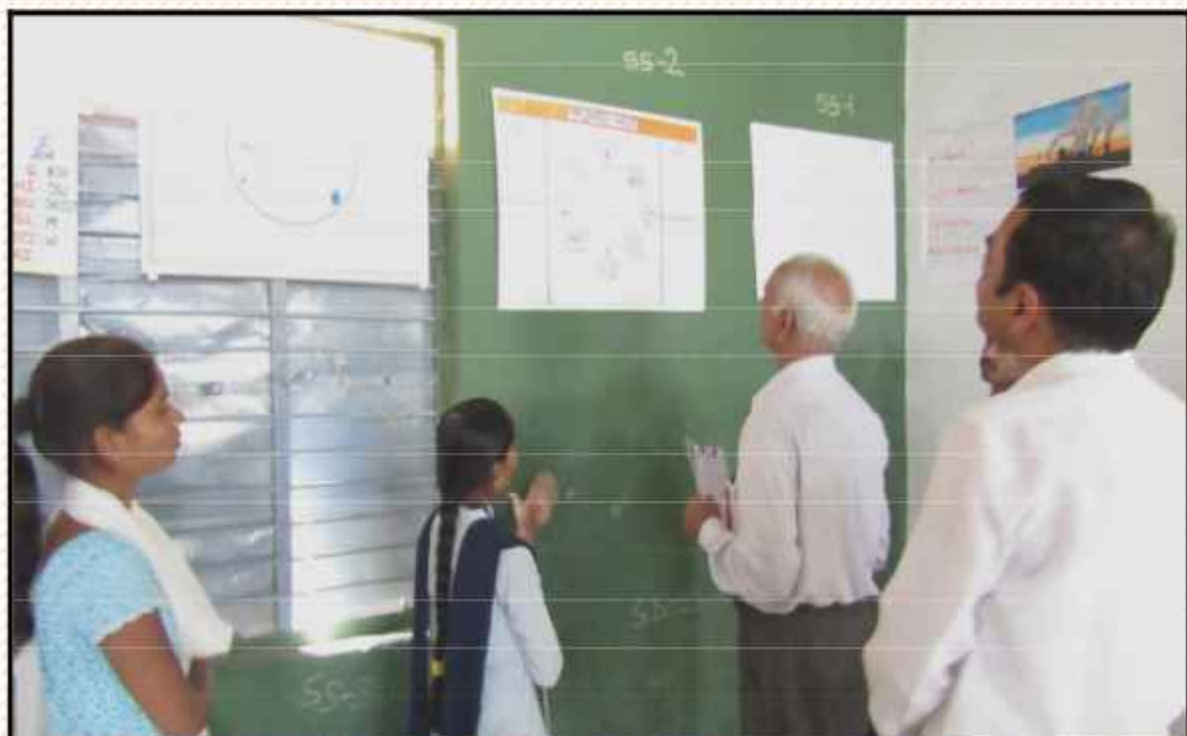

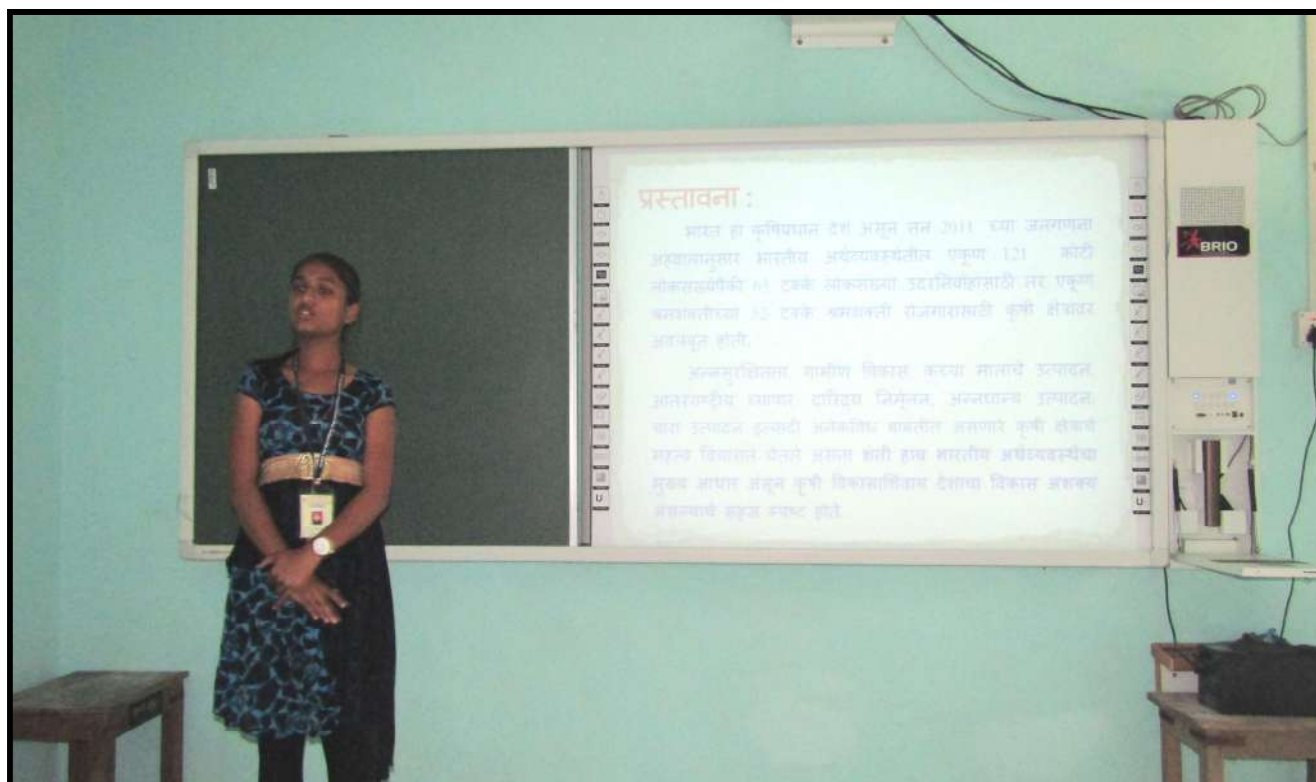

Government COVID-19 Relief Package and its utility for Women in Informal Sector and Focus Areas to strategic responses to re-build the lives and livelihoods of women.

- Economic package of 10 lakh crore i.e. 10% of GDP. Social movements has alleged it as RWMA, not a relief package.
- Priority areas: MSMEs, Migrant workers, agricultural infrastructure, Coal mining & defense manufacture, NAWREGA.

- Reality bites: On paper Rs. 17%, but actual wages 230 and women workers get Rs. 120/-
- Increase in borrowing limit of the scale for 3% to 5% -frontline of COVID-19 work.
- Spending will only be allowed for PM's Garib Kalyan Niyama and arrangement under Atmanirbhar Bharat Yojana. Ministry of Finance has decided to put on hold all new schemes till 31-3-2021.
- Increase in public health expenditure and better preparedness for future pandemics- In all district hospitals, starting infectious disease block and public health laboratory, insurance cover of Rs. 50 lakh per person for health professionals. Rs. 6,100 crore in its stimulus package.
- Allocation of Rs. 15000 crore for health-related measures to tackle COVID-19-highly inadequate. As per WHO recommendation, public health budget MUST be 6% of GDP i.e. 12 lakh crore.

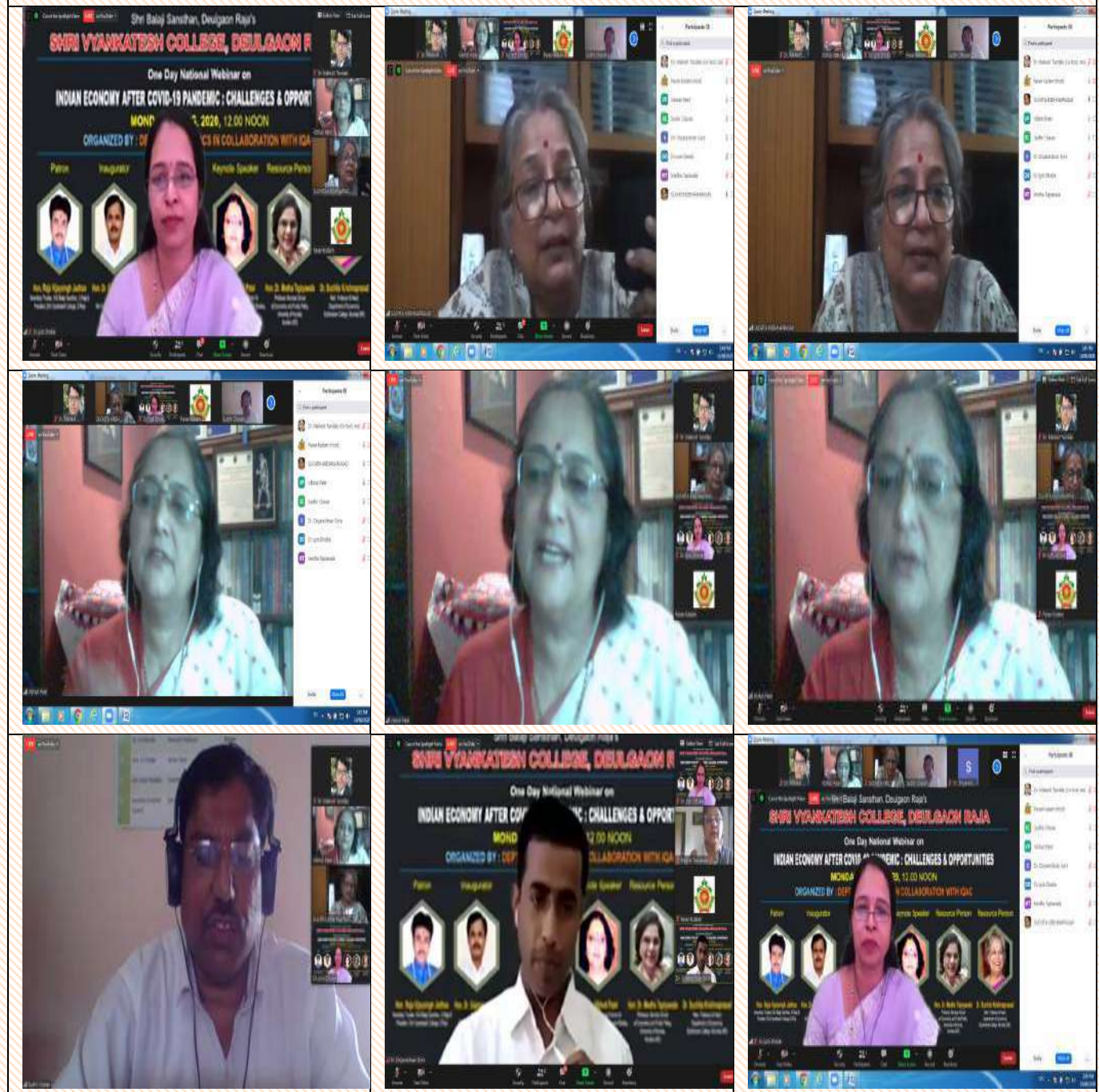

Women as Health Care seeker

During the last 5 weeks pandemic, most of the private nursing homes have been closed down; services of coronavirus infected public hospitals and health posts have stopped and their health care providers are quarantined, and the remaining health care services are catering to patients of coronavirus.

Thus, highly inadequate public health services have been directed to treatment of COVID-19 patients and testing of all those who have come in their contact. As a result, women's access to reproductive and maternal health care have been severely hampered. Health care for women i.e. timely access to necessary and comprehensive sexual and reproductive health services during the crisis, such as emergency contraception, safe abortion and safe childbirth needs to be resumed urgently by the Public Health Department of the Government.

Maintain an adequate stock of menstrual hygiene products at healthcare and community facilities. Train medical staff and frontline social workers to recognize signs of domestic violence and provide appropriate resources and services.

Now, the MCOB commissioner had sent a directive to them conveying that if private medical practitioners do not open their nursing homes, their registration as medical practitioners would be cancelled.
